## Course Outcome

### **Academic:**

The real test for the extent in which teaching learning has been effective is reflected by the students performance in examinations. Students success is seen as the realization of learning outcomes which are specifications of what a student should be capable of doing on successful completion of a course and program.

Curriculum is designed in such a way that desired outcome of the learning process in terms of skill development, up-gradation of knowledge and placement is attained to satisfaction. Hence all the stated Learning outcomes are the products of evaluation procedures. IQAC of the college analyses the outcomes of the programs.

After the declaration of the results of examinations and other activities, they are analyzed to know the number of students passed in distinction, first class, passing percentage and awards secured. In the last five years (2012- 2013 to 2016 – 17), 680 students out of 1268 those who appeared for the final year University examination have had passed and the average passing percentage in all three faculties is 56.013. About 10 - 15% passed in distinction and 25 – 40% in first class.

Around **75-80%** of the M.Sc. chemistry students have been placed in various chemical and pharmaceutical companies every year either through on campus or off campus interviews in the last five years.

The outcomes are communicated by the institution to students by display either on notice board or by HoD of the department and also uploading on the college website.

### **Co-curricular:**

Students are encouraged to participate in various competitions, competitive examinations and are made aware of the opportunities and scope in their career. These students carry out low level research project work, present research papers in various conferences, seminars, workshops and appear for the qualifying examinations like GATE, JRE, SET, and NET.

Two students were qualified in the NET and one student Mr. Aslam Shaikh passed NET, SLET, GATE and JRF. The department of chemistry has organized Soil and Water Analysis workshop for UG and PG students in Feb, 2017.

Science Association Committee organizes science exhibition in month of February every year to motivate the students and keep them abreast of the current developments in science and technology. A total of 116 exhibits in the form of models, experiments and posters were displayed in the exhibitions organized in the last five years. The exhibits were evaluated by the committee and awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes accordingly.

Students learnt about the various methods to be followed in research in the UGC sponsored workshop on “Advances of Research Methodology in Higher Education” organized in January 2016.

42 students presented the findings of their project work in the National and State level seminars.

Due to the bridge courses and remedial courses in Physics, Mathematics, Economics, Accounts and Chemistry, the passing percentage has considerably increased.

The students have gained subject knowledge during the industrial/field visits organized by various departments every year.

#### **Extra-curricular:**

The college is awarded with **Best College Award** by Savitribai Phule Pune University for the student welfare activity during year 2016-17.

The college sports department organizes various sports events every year for the students. Students of the college have participated in State as well National level sport events organized by various associations.

Mr. Bharat Anap has bagged two **Gold Medals** in National level **Strength Lifting and Incline Bench Press championship in 2013-14 and 2014-15** and one Gold medal in National level **Javelin Throw Standing** event in 2016-17. Also one Gold medal at State level in 2014-15 in the similar events organized by Student Olympic Association, India.

Similarly, Mr. Nitin Ghorpade has bagged **bronze Medal** (National) in 2016-17 in running event in 16<sup>th</sup> Senior National Para Athletics Championship organized during 2016-17 by Student Olympic Association, India.

Miss Renuka Gagare secured Gold medal in the “Inter Zonal Road Race Cycling Tournament” organized by the Savitribai Phule Pune University in September, 2014.

The college NSS volunteers are actively involved in various community oriented activities like socio – economic and health surveys, tree plantation, energy conservation and HIV-AIDS awareness during the seven days special camp in the adopted village every year.

During the camp period, 71 students had donated blood and 235 saplings were planted in the last five years.

In the survey, about 15% of the villagers were found to be socially and 32% economically backward.

125 NSS volunteers rendered their services in the smooth conduct of Shri Sant Gangagiri Maharaj Akhand Harinam Saptah (A seven days religious discourse) organized in August 2016 at Tandulner village. This event was recorded in the Guinness Book of World Records and the college received appreciation letter from the organizers.

The skill oriented courses and certificate courses enabled maximum students in achieving the skills in respective courses. The Personality Development Program organizes every year under vocational course help students in facing on and off campus interview. The certificate course in English Proficiency improved to some extent the communication skills of the students, Agricultural Retail Marketing enabled them to determine the cost in market, data entry helped student to know methodology of collecting and analyzing the data.

Most of the students have become successful entrepreneurs in various sectors and provided employment to many.
